	<u>GREEN DOT ADVANCED 10U LEAGUE FORMAT & RULES</u>
Match Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 10U Advanced matches are held on Saturday afternoons.
Match Locations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Matches are both “home” and “away”.
Serve	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Players alternate serving games. Adult service motion is expected.
Season Duration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 6-10 matches, depending on the number of registered teams. Typically, the spring season runs April 2nd-May 30th. Typically the fall season runs from Sept. 24-Nov. 15.
Number of matches weekly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> One match weekly on Saturday afternoons.
Court Size	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adult size court
Ball	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Green Dot ball
Team Size	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minimum 4 players to a team; ideally 6 players.
Team Gender	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any gender at any line, Players may be any combination of boys and girls.
Match Format	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Match format- 2 singles and 1 doubles
Doubling Up ?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Doubles players may also play singles (doubling up is allowed).
Scoring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> MATCH SCORING: Two, 4 game short sets. Third deciding “set” is 7 point tiebreak, win by 1. First player to reach 4 games, wins set. At 3-3, it's win by one game. If players split sets, the deciding set is a 7 point tiebreak, win by one. Tiebreaker is always recorded as 1-0. (Tiebreak Instructions are detailed next) No Ad scoring. Receiving team picks their preferred side to return from at Deuce.
3rd Set Tiebreak	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The first server is determined by continuing the service rotation of the current set. Start the serve for the first point on the deuce side (right). After the first point, the opposite team or player serves twice: the first on the ad (left) followed by the second on the deuce (right) side. The rotation of servers continues with each server serving two points, the first point on ad side and the second point on the deuce side. After 6 total points are played, the players or teams switch ends of the court. Switching continues after every 6 points. The winner is the first player to reach 7; YOU CAN WIN BY 1 point. The Tiebreak score is recorded as 1-0.
Match Winner	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> TEAM MATCH WINNER IS DECIDED BY TOTAL GAMES. How many games did each of your players get (added up), versus how many games did each of their players get (added up).
Age Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can't turn 11 before 8/31. Age Eligibility may be flexible at the discretion of the Coordinator.
Team Parent Liason	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each Advanced 10U Team needs a team parent volunteer to liaison with league staff.
USTA Membership Requirement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If this is your child's first year playing JTT, their USTA annual dues are FREE! Please ask for the code. (Player Registration fee still applies.)
JTT Fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> JTT Player Registration Fee: \$45
ENTERING MATCH SCORES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> HOME TEAM ENTERS SCORES.
Court Monitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Court monitors are not required for 10U Advanced.
Match Order of Play	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Doubles teams may start after the singles is completed or play simultaneously with singles courts.
Player Level	<p>*** Your child may play in this Green Dot division even if they have not cleared their “Orange Ball Youth Progression Level”. BUT- Please speak with your coach before registering .</p>
Lineup Courtesies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Parent Volunteers exchange lineups 5 minutes before match time. If a child is sick or a no show, you may switch lineup. If you know in advance that you can not field a full team, please contact the opposing captain. Strength of players is indicated by how high in the lineup they should play. All players must be registered before they play in a match.
Team Advancement ?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teams are eligible for JTT Advancement to Regional competition at the discretion of the Coordinator.
